

Chernoff breaks Canadian record

Kendra Chernoff of the Saskatoon Goldfins Swim Club broke the Canadian record in the 100-metre butterfly, but finished second at the Canadian summer nationals/world aquatic championship trials in Montreal on Friday.

Chernoff set the record of 58.70 seconds during qualifying in the morning. The previous record was 58.88, set by MacKenzie Downing of Victoria in 2007.

Chernoff finished second in the final in 59.48. Audrey Lacroix of Montreal was first in 59.40.
