University of Alberta volleyball player Tiffany Dodds was awarded the Canadian Interuniversity Sport - VIA Rail female athletes of the week for the period ending March 4, 2007.

Dodds, a third-year physical education and recreation student from Lucky Lake, Sask. enjoyed a dream weekend in Calgary where she was named CIS championship MVP and led the volleyball Pandas to their first national title since 2000, only a few days after being chosen CIS player of the year. The six-foot-three hitter had 59 kills and 21 blocks in three matches, including an amazing 32 kills to only four errors in a five-set semi-final win over arch-rival Calgary, and 17 kills in a 3-1 gold-medal victory over defending champion Laval.

Basketball players Maegan Seaward of Memorial and Kim Gibbs of York, as well as Concordia wrestler Hana Askren were also nominated for the weekly honour.
